APPLICATION TO REGISTER BOATS

SPECIAL NOTICE - INVASIVE SPECIES

Invasive species from around the globe threaten Lake George as well as many other water bodies. The Lake George Park Commission is working to eradicate Eurasian Watermilfoil in our waters and leads a community wide effort to stop new invasive species before they can get a stranglehold on the lake. The participation of every citizen is needed to prevent the destructive consequences of invasive species. **Destructive animals are transported as microscopic larvae in standing water.**

Before launching your boat in Lake George and when leaving, please:

INSPECT

Thoroughly inspect all boat and trailer parts for marine growth. Do not launch with plants, animals or standing water present.

REMOVE

Remove all visible plant, animal material and mud.

DRAIN and DRY

Pull boat plug, drain or remove all bilge water and livewell and allow the boat to dry for several days before launch. If the equipment is not allowed to dry follow the rinse instructions below.

DISCARD

Discard bait buckets and material away from the lake.

RINSE

Drain and rinse the boat's exterior and internal wet locations with water. Use **HOT** water when possible (above 140°) to ensure plant and animal growth is removed. If hot water is not available use tap water.

Inspecting your boat for Aquatic Invasive Species is **REQUIRED by LAW** and appreciated to ensure the waters of Lake George are protected now and for future generations.

PROTECT **Lake George** STOP THESE **AQUATIC INVADERS!**



WARNING:
These Invasive species are not native to Lake George. They can affect human health, reduce native species, degrade eco-systems and affect local economies.

Before moving boats between bodies of water always:

- Pull boat plug, drain bilge and live well before launch
- Inspect all boat and trailer parts
- Remove all visible plant, animal material & mud
- Discard bait buckets/materials away from lake
- Rinse all boat parts and equipment with tap water

THE BOAT REGISTRATION FEES ARE DEPOSITED TO THE LAKE GEORGE PARK TRUST FUND AND CAN ONLY BE USED BY THE COMMISSION TO PROTECT THE LAKE AND ITS USERS. THE COMMISSION IS AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY OF NINE VOLUNTEER CITIZENS, RESIDING IN THE THREE COUNTIES BORDERING THE LAKE, AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, EX-OFFICIO.

FEE SCHEDULE

STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT ALL VESSELS 18 FEET OR LONGER, OR ANY VESSEL MECHANICALLY PROPELLED BY A MOTOR 10 H.P. OR GREATER, MUST REGISTER WITH THE LAKE GEORGE PARK COMMISSION AND DISPLAY A REGISTRATION DECAL.

CALCULATING YOUR ANNUAL BOAT FEE: First, determine whether the boat to be registered is "equipped for overnight accommodations." Boats equipped for overnight have a bed or bunk and sanitary facilities such as a toilet, shower, sink, kitchen, whether or not a marine toilet has been removed from the vessel. Boats may be equipped for overnight whether or not used for overnight stays.

Next, determine the boat length. (check your state registration documentation) Boat length is the distance overall from the foremost part of the bow to the aftermost part of the stern excluding bow pulpits, swim decks, engines, props, brackets, etc. Many boats have a capacity plant which provides the overall length.

UNDER PENALTY OF LAW, BOAT REGISTRATIONS MUST CONFORM TO THE ACTUAL BOAT LENGTH AND EQUIPMENT.

Fee schedules require rounding UPWARD to the next highest full foot for boats longer than 25 feet. Read across to find the category (equipped or not equipped). Read down to find the fee for the boat length. Sign and Date Registration Form.
